

FOREIGN AID - Handout

Assignment Guidelines

1. Your group must first research all the NGOs in your category. As you become familiar with these organizations, use the class brainstorming ideas, as well as ideas of your own, to decide how you are going to rate your organizations. You must come up with five categories for your rubric.
2. Once you have developed your rubric, apply it to the organizations in your category and decide as a group which organization you would like to recommend CIDA fund.
3. Create poster including the following:
 - A. Inform the class about your international development category. What is your category? What kind of work do NGOs from your category do? Why is this work important? Why is there a need for this kind of work?
 - B. Name the five organizations that "competed" for the one million dollar grant.
 - C. Show the rubric your group designed to grade these organizations.
 - D. Give information about the winning organization. What does the organization do? Where do they work? Where are they based? Talk about at least one of their projects. Why did they win? What did they score in each of your rubric's categories? Give any other information your group feels is relevant.
4. Your group must then prepare a presentation. The presentation should be 15-20 minutes in length. Each group member should take a turn speaking. Please present all the ideas that are required to be on your poster (A, B, C, & D above).
5. As a nice touch your group could compose an email to the winning organization, letting them know about your project, and why you selected them for the hypothetical funding!
