A Cool Drink of Water	Kerley, Barbara	<i>Primary</i> - Depicts people around the world collecting, chilling, and drinking water.
The Water Hole	Base, Graeme	<i>Primary</i> - As evergrowing numbers of animals visit a watering hole, introducing the numbers 1 – 10, the water dwindles.
Water Hole	Kurtz, Jane	<i>Primary</i> - A thirsty monkey waits as the larger animals drink from the water hole on the African Savannah.
Thirst	Taylor Catherine	<i>Primary</i> - Water, animals, language arts, pollution, swimming.
Ellen Fremedon	Givner, Joan	<i>Junior fiction</i> - Eleven year old Ellen discovers that her new neighbours are behind a housing project that will endanger a town's water supply.
Hey Frog !	Grobier, Piet	<i>Picture Book</i> - On a very hot day, the animals are roaring mad when a frog drinks up all of the water on the Savannah, but each animal has an idea of how to get the water back.
A Fish Out of Water	Palmer ,Helen	<i>Primary</i> - Comic pictures show how a fish rapidly outgrows its bowl, a vase, a cook pot, and a bathtub.
White Water	London, Jonathan	<i>Junior Fiction</i> - A boy learns to read the river when he goes white water rafting with his Dad.
No More Water in the Tub	Arnold, Ted	<i>Picture Book</i> - After filling the bathtub too full one night, William goes sailing through his apt.
This is the Rain	Schaefer, Lola M.	<i>Picture Book</i> - Describes how water falls from the sky as rain, and eventually makes its way to the sea.
